MARK'S MUSINGS

Dear Friends,

Before the death and resurrection of Jesus, he said to his disciples, "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you forever." They did not understand what he was saying, but took it in, anyway. Jesus knew they would understand before too long.

Jesus knew he was going to return to heaven. He also knew the disciples, then and now, would need to know of God's continued presence in every aspect of life. This is why Jesus promised the Advocate, God's Holy Spirit, would come to them.

Sure enough, 50 days after the Passover festival they celebrated together, that promise was fulfilled.

Passover marked the beginning of the reaping season. A week of weeks later (49 days), the reaping season came to an end with the Feast of Weeks. This feast was celebrated on the 50th day after Passover. The word Pentecost is the Greek for the fiftieth day.

The multitudes gathered in Jerusalem to celebrate the Feast of Weeks. It was always a huge

festival. This particular festival was after Jesus has been crucified and resurrected. The disciples had gathered in the same upper room to celebrate.

As they were together, the promise of Jesus was fulfilled. God's Holy Spirit, the Advocate, the Counselor, the Comforter, came into that room and filled the disciples with the power and conviction they needed to go about doing the work and ministry begun by Jesus.

Peter proclaimed Christ crucified and resurrected to the people in the area who presumed the disciples were drunk. His message was heard and understood by all persons regardless of their language. This was the start of a movement that would change the world – forever.

Because of God's actions that day, it is said that Pentecost is the birthday of the Church – the Body of Christ on earth.

Coming up on Sunday, June 4, we will be celebrating the Day of Pentecost. In both our congregations we will give thanks to God for his amazing gift of Jesus Christ, and for the privilege of serving as our Lord's ambassadors. We will have the joy of celebrating the

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL. Plans are underway for this year's Vacation Bible

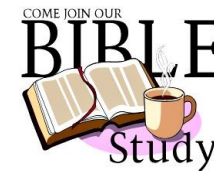
