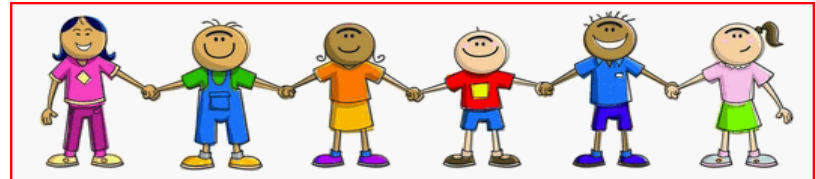
Movie – Lunch After Church

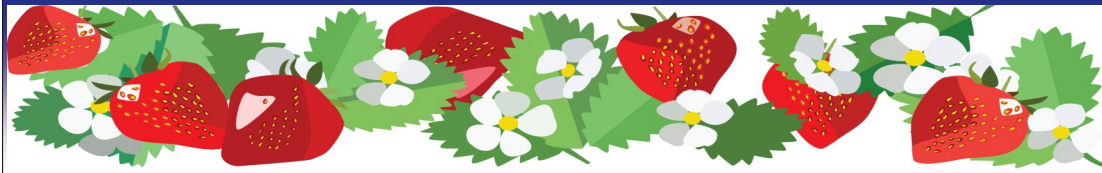
